

The Classic Story of the Three Little Classrooms

Set and Cast: Three “classrooms”- each with a chair, flashlight and a teacher. Classroom one has a few students sitting on the floor around the chair. A few Watt Watchers on patrol (with lanyard or notebooks to identify them). Narrator

Scene 1: All the classrooms are full. The teachers are at their chairs with their flashlights on. Narrator explains the classrooms.

Narrator: “ Mrs. Straw is in her classroom teaching her students about housing, Mrs. Sticks is in her classroom grading papers, and Mrs. Bricks is in her classroom calling parents.”

Mrs. Straw in classroom one: continues to teach as the Watt Watchers come by.

Watt Watchers on patrol: The Watt Watchers come to the first room. Seeing the students learning they turn to the audience and say: “Teacher is here, students are here, leave the lights on. Place a check on the form- no waste going on”

Scene 2:

Mrs. Sticks in classroom two stands up from her chair and leaving her flashlight on, places it on her chair pointing the light at the audience. She leaves her room.

Narrator: “Mrs. Sticks leaves her classroom to go to a meeting.”

Watt Watchers on patrol: The Watt Watchers turn back to the classrooms and go to classroom number two. They see the light on and look inside. Seeing no teacher, they turn to the audience and gasp: “Teacher is gone, lights are on, wasting energy. Place an X on the form and leave her a ticket. Teach her off, off, off”

Scene 3:

Mrs. Bricks in classroom three: Stands up from her chair, turns off her flashlight and leaves it on the chair. She leaves her classroom.

Narrator: “Mrs. Bricks leaves her classroom to go speak with the counselors.”

Watt Watchers on patrol: The Watt Watchers turn back to the classrooms and go to classroom number three. They see the light is off and look inside. Seeing no teacher they turn to the audience and cheer: “Teacher is gone, lights are off, saving energy. Place a zero on the form and leave her a thank you. Praise her off, off, off.”

Narrator: “And this is the well known story of the three little classrooms. Now, what happens next...?”
