

The Classic Story of the Three Little Classrooms

Set and Cast: Three “classrooms”- each with a chair, flashlight and a teacher. One of the classrooms has a few students sitting on the floor around the chair. A few Watt Watchers on patrol. Narrator

Scene 1: All classrooms are full. The teachers are at their chairs with their flashlights on. Narrator may want to explain the classrooms.
“ Mrs. Straw is in her classroom teaching about housing, Mrs. Sticks is in her classroom grading papers, and Mrs. Bricks is in her classroom calling parents.”

The Watt Watchers come to the first room. Seeing the students learning they turn to the audience and say:

“Teacher’s here, Students here, leave the lights on”
“Place a check on the form- no waste going on”

As they are facing forward, the second teacher places her flashlight on her chair (ON) and leaves her classroom.

Scene 2: Watt Watchers turn back to the classrooms and go to classroom number two. They see the light on and look inside. Seeing no teacher, they turn to the audience and gasp:
“Teacher’s gone, Lights are on, wasting energy”
“Leave her a ticket, teach her off, off, off”

While the Watt Watchers are facing forward, the teacher from classroom number three turns off her flashlight and leaves it on the chair then leaves the room.

Scene 3: Watt Watchers turn back to the classrooms and go to classroom number three. They see the light is off and look inside. Seeing no teacher they turn to the audience and cheer:
“Teacher’s gone, lights are off, saving energy “
“Leave her a thank you, praise her off, off, off”

Narrator: “And this is the well know story of the three little classrooms. Now, what happens next...?”
